The Royal Naval Air Service (RNAS) created an Armoured Car Section in 1914 for communications security and to retrieve downed aircrew.

The trench warfare of the Western Front saw it disbanded, but they were redeployed to Russia and fought the rest of the war on the Eastern Front.
