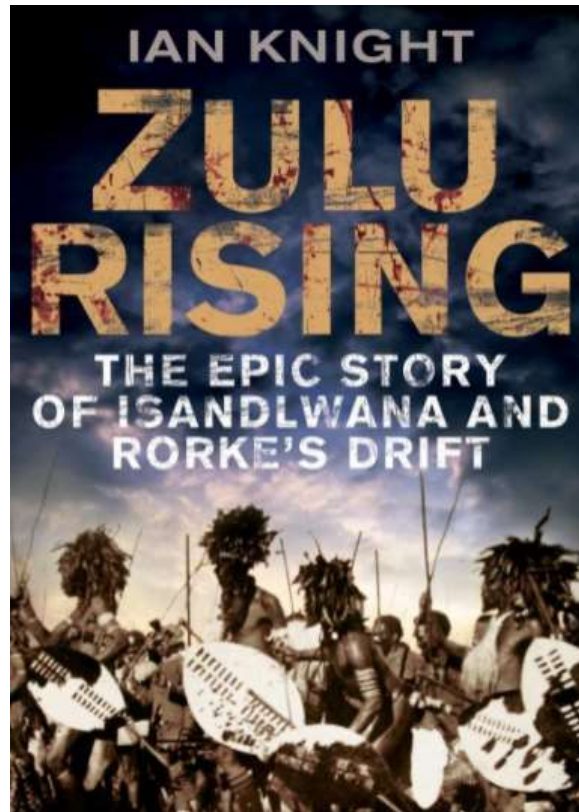




# Zulu Rising: The epic story of the battle of Isandlwana
